AB 118 Program – AFRVT

- Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program
- Run by California Energy Commission
- At least \$12 million per year for vehicle buy-down incentives and infrastructure support
- Last offering was
 - \$3,000/vehicle up to 8,500 lbs GVWR
 - \$8,000/vehicle 8,501–14,000 lbs GVWR
- Work with OEM or up-fitter to apply

Clean Car "White Sticker" Program

- High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lane access for qualifying single occupant vehicles
- Vehicles must meet both CA SULEV and federal ILEV emission standards
- No weight class restriction
- Program extended through 2014
- Assembly Bill 2405 on Governor's desk would ensure access to High Occupancy Toll (HOT) lanes with a couple of exceptions

Low Carbon Fuel Standard

- calls for a reduction of at least 10 percent in the carbon intensity of California's transportation fuels by 2020.
- Puts pressure on oil refiners to produce, use, sell lower carbon fuels or buy credits
- Natural gas one of the low carbon fuels able to generate credits
- Impact of this program as an incentive for natural gas will increase significantly as compliance requirements get tougher in the future

Additional efforts

- Improving ARB's certification program for alternative fuel vehicles
- Securing more incentive funding
- ▶ In state manufacturing of NGVs/components
- NGV Research and development
- State fleet purchases

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
