

Utility Response 1:

a: SoCalGas took several factors in consideration before determining the location for the new office buildings. Foremost, the company examined areas that were proximate to the main plant, since this is paramount for safety. Proximity to existing utilities also fostered cost savings.

The local topography was another important factor. Flat space is extremely limited at the Aliso Canyon Storage Field and minimization of earthwork reduced costs and environmental impact. See images below for details on space availability at the Facility.



In addition to the employees assigned to that work location, 335 Utilities' employees may occasionally work at Aliso Canyon Station.

Utility Response 4:

- a. The number of employees and contractors working at the Aliso Canyon Station fluctuates based on activities being performed at the facility. In 2019, the portion of full-time Company employees who require at least 50 percent of their time outside of the office is approximately 35%.
- b. The number of employees and contractors working at the Aliso Canyon Station fluctuates based on activities being performed at the facility. In 2019, the portion of full-time Company employees who require at least 75 percent of their time in the office is approximately 65%.
- c. There are currently 19 employees in a supervisory position at the Aliso Canyon Station.
- d. There are currently 54 management employees at the Aliso Canyon Station, including the 19 employees in supervisory roles. These 54 employees are considered "management" resources as opposed to represented workers. The 19 employees in supervisory positions have Company employees reporting to them, the other 35 do not have other Company employees reporting to them.
