
1. Program description

The California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation/Investor Owned Utility Energy Efficiency Partnership is a unique, statewide program to achieve immediate and longterm energy savings and peak demand reduction within California's.

The program will offer incentives for retrofit projects, continuous commissioning, and educational training for the prisons and youth facilities.
