Mark, per our discussion, I have delivered the signed Program Changes Checklist for SCG Steam Traps, Green House Heat Curtain and Green House Infra Red Film regarding the requested therm savings corrections in EETs to you today.

I am attaching the workpapers for the Steam Traps and Green House curtain and Infra red film. Per Eric Kirchhoff's email below, he accepts the technical aspects of the steam trap workpapers, but is requesting some verbiage changes, and we will send the corrected papers as soon as we receive them. Eric ok'd the Green House workpapers back in September, and the approval was sent to San Diego, but I do not have a record of it. Eric will give me a formal email oking the Green House workpapers, and I will forward it to you.

I believe that it is imperative that we begin making the savings reductions immediately in EETs so that we can have accurate reports for PY2006, so I am sending this to you to begin implementation. I have made the savings adjustments to Program Builder for 2006, and have marked the changed form titled SoCalGas Express Efficiency Program w/boiler/st/ghc/ghf changes as "proposed". Please note that the only choice of a Program Builder form that I had to start with is the form that I submitted earlier this year with the boiler changes. That is why the boiler areas are also yellow indicating changes. It probably wouldn't hurt to make sure that those value changes were actually made in EETs, as I never received confirmation.
