The California Advanced Homes Program (CAHP) is a comprehensive residential new construction program with a cross-cutting focus on energy efficiency, sustainable design and construction, and emerging technologies.

SoCalGas® and the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) are working together to help the building industry smoothly transition to California's next state building code, develop more environmentally-friendly communities, and support state efforts for new homes to reach Zero Net Energy (ZNE).

### Services

- Financial incentives to help offset costs of creating environmentally-friendly energy-efficient homes and communities
  - Signed CAHP Incentive Agreements must be postmarked or received no later than December 31, 2019
- Design assistance to support development of sustainable and livable communities by incorporating energy efficiency, green building practices and demand response initiatives
- Dedicated account representatives provide builders with recommendations necessary to improve the energy performance of the homes they are building and communicate the associated benefits of building a CAHP-qualified home
- Technical support that performs a comprehensive review and verification to assure projects meet program entry requirements.

# Single-family


The "CAHP Delta Energy Design Rating" (EDR) is the difference between the "Standard Design EDR" and the "Proposed Design EDR" plus "Kicker Points". For single-family, the minimum performance requirement is a CAHP Delta EDR of 2. Incentives rise incrementally as the performance of the building increases.

#### **CAHP Incentive Structure**

Baseline financial incentives:

Single-family		
Entry CAHP Delta EDR	2	
Entry Incentive	\$300/lot	
Increment Incentive for Delta EDR points 3,4,5, & 6	\$150/lot	
Inflection CAHP Delta EDR	6	
Incentive for Delta EDR point $\geq 7$	\$300/lot

## Additional Financial Incentives

CAHP offers additional financial incentives, also called "kickers", to projects that include one or more of the elements in the Program Kickers Table. NOTE: Multiple kickers can be claimed on a project. Kicker EDR points are added to the delta EDR to attain the project's CAHP EDR score and can further increase a project's incentive. EDR points are included in the Title 24 compliance software and are shown on the CAHP Incentive Report.

# Thermostatic Shower Restriction Valve – \$7/unit or \$15/set when combined with low-flow showerhead

Projects that install thermostatic shower restriction valves are eligible for this incentive. This is a natural gas-only incentive and not applicable with electric water heating or when combined with recirculation pumps or tankless water heaters (natural gas or electric).
